Figure 202: Domestic market cap of top ranked exchanges*





Figure 203: Number of trades in Cash market of top ranked exchanges*

Figure 204: Number of contracts traded in Stock futures of top-ranked exchanges*





Figure 205: Number of contracts traded in Stock options of top-ranked exchanges*





Figure 207: Number of trades in Index options of top ranked exchanges*





Figure 209: Number of trades in Currency options of top ranked exchanges*




