Corporate governance plays a key role for corporations navigating such a rapidly changing business environment. In particular, resilience and sustainability are essential to creating long-term value. The roundtable brings together experiences and insights on how corporate governance can support corporations' sustainability and resilience. For example, Japan will share its efforts to attain effective governance that supports long-term sustainable growth. The review of the G20/OECD Principles of Corporate Governance, the single global standard in the area of corporate governance, will be also highlighted. The review will be reported on at the G20 Leaders Summit in September.
